

Trial Terms of Service

Anubion ApS — Azure Governance & Operations Platform

14-Day Free Trial — No credit card required

By completing the trial sign-up form on anubion.io and ticking the box to accept these terms, you — on behalf of the company you represent — enter into a legally binding agreement with Anubion ApS. Please read these Trial Terms of Service and the Anubion Data Processing Agreement carefully before signing up. If you do not accept these terms, do not sign up for the trial.

Trial duration: 14 days from the date of sign-up

Access: Full access to all platform features during the trial

Day 15: Access closes automatically — no charge, no action required

Your data: Retained for 30 days after trial expiry, then permanently deleted

Return policy: This 14-day free trial constitutes Anubion's full return policy

Cost: Free — no credit card required at sign-up

1. Scope and Acceptance

These Trial Terms of Service (the "Trial Terms") govern your company's 14-day free trial of the Anubion ApS Azure governance and operations SaaS platform (the "Service"). "Anubion", "we", "us", and "our" refer to Anubion ApS, CVR 46357337, St.St.Blichers Vej 17, 8370 Hadsten, Denmark. "Customer", "you", and "your" refer to the legal entity on whose behalf these Trial Terms are accepted.

By completing the sign-up form on anubion.io and ticking the box indicating acceptance of these Trial Terms and the Anubion Data Processing Agreement, the individual completing the form represents and warrants that:

- They are authorised to enter into legally binding agreements on behalf of the Customer.
- They have read and understood these Trial Terms and the Data Processing Agreement.
- The Customer is a legal entity (company) and not a private individual.

Upon submission of the sign-up form with the acceptance box ticked, a binding agreement is formed between Anubion ApS and the Customer. Anubion records the date, time, accepting user's name and email, Customer legal entity name and registration number, and version of the accepted documents for documentation purposes.

2. Relationship to the Data Processing Agreement

These Trial Terms govern the commercial aspects of the trial period only. Processing of personal data during the trial is governed by the separate Anubion Data Processing Agreement (the "DPA"), which is incorporated into this agreement by reference and which the Customer also accepts upon sign-up.

In the event of any conflict between these Trial Terms and the DPA regarding the processing of personal data, the DPA shall prevail. In all other matters, these Trial Terms shall prevail.

3. Trial Period and Access

3.1 Duration

The trial period begins on the date of sign-up and ends automatically at 23:59 CET on the 14th calendar day thereafter (the "Trial End Date"). No action is required by either party to trigger the end of the trial — access ceases automatically on the Trial End Date.

3.2 Scope of access

During the trial period, the Customer has full access to all features of the Service, including:

- Continuous assessment of the Customer's Azure environment against CIS, Cloud Adoption Framework (CAF), and Well-Architected Framework (WAF).
- Executive summary reports with risk themes.
- Actionable recommendations across all three frameworks.
- Task management functionality to delegate and track remediation work.

The Customer acknowledges that the Service connects to the Customer's Microsoft Azure environment via a read-only service principal installed by the Customer. Anubion does not make any changes to the Customer's Azure environment. The service principal can be removed by the Customer at any time.

3.3 Nature of the trial service

The Service is provided as a fully operational production platform during the trial. Anubion makes no distinction between trial and paid access in terms of feature availability. Anubion gives no warranty that the Service will be error-free or uninterrupted, but applies the same commercially reasonable standard of care during the trial as it does for paying customers.

4. Fees

The trial is provided entirely free of charge. No fees, subscription costs, or credit card details are required at sign-up. The Customer is not charged for any period of trial use.

If the Customer wishes to continue using the Service after the Trial End Date, it must enter into a paid subscription agreement with Anubion. Continued use after the Trial End Date is not possible without a paid subscription — access closes automatically.

5. Return Policy and Trial Commitment

This 14-day free trial constitutes Anubion's full return and cancellation policy for new customers. Specifically:

- The Customer has 14 days from sign-up to evaluate the Service at no cost and with no obligation to purchase.
- Because the trial is free of charge, there is no payment to refund. The Customer's 'return' is the right to walk away at day 14 without any charge, obligation, or penalty.

- The Customer is not required to give notice of non-renewal. If no paid subscription is entered into by the Trial End Date, access simply closes and no further action is required.
- If the Customer enters into a paid subscription during the trial period and subsequently wishes to cancel, the cancellation terms of the paid subscription agreement apply. The return policy described in this Clause 5 applies to the trial period only and does not extend to paid subscriptions.

For the avoidance of doubt: these Trial Terms are a business-to-business agreement. The statutory right of withdrawal applicable to consumer contracts under EU and Danish consumer protection law does not apply.

6. Data, Retention, and Deletion

Processing of personal data during the trial is governed in full by the Anubion Data Processing Agreement accepted at sign-up.

In addition, the following trial-specific data commitments apply:

- All personal data and Customer data collected or processed during the trial period will be retained for a maximum of 30 days after the Trial End Date to allow the Customer to retrieve its data or reconsider and enter into a paid subscription. After 30 days, all data is permanently and securely deleted.
- If the Customer enters into a paid subscription before or during the 30-day retention window, data continues to be processed under the terms of the paid subscription agreement. No data migration or re-onboarding is required.
- The Customer may request export or deletion of its data at any time during or after the trial by contacting Anubion. Anubion will fulfil export requests within 5 business days and deletion requests within 2 business days.
- The Customer shall decommission the Azure service principal installed for the trial no later than 30 days after the Trial End Date if it does not enter into a paid subscription. Anubion will send a reminder at the Trial End Date.

Anubion will provide written confirmation of data deletion to the Customer's registered email address within 7 days of permanent deletion being completed.

7. Liability

Anubion's liability during the trial period is limited as follows:

- Anubion shall not be liable for any loss, damage, or costs arising from defects, errors, interruptions, or limitations in the Service during the trial, provided Anubion has acted in good faith and has not engaged in gross negligence or wilful misconduct.
- Anubion shall not be liable for any indirect, consequential, or incidental loss arising from the Customer's use of or reliance on the Service during the trial, including loss of data, loss of business, or reputational damage.
- Anubion is liable only where the loss or damage is directly caused by Anubion's gross negligence, wilful misconduct, or breach of the data deletion obligations in Clause 6.

The data deletion obligations in Clause 6 are unconditional. Failure to delete data within the timeframes stated constitutes a material breach, and Anubion remains fully liable for any resulting loss or damage without the benefit of the liability limitations above.

8. Customer Representations

By accepting these Trial Terms, the Customer represents and warrants that:

- The Customer is a private legal entity
- The Customer has the legal authority and technical capability to install a read-only service principal in its Microsoft Azure environment.
- The Customer has a valid legal basis under GDPR for making any personal data available to Anubion through the Service.
- The individual accepting these terms has authority to bind the Customer.

9. Changes to These Terms

Anubion may update these Trial Terms from time to time. Material changes affecting the Customer's rights or obligations will be communicated by email to the registered contact address before taking effect. The version accepted at sign-up is archived and available to the Customer upon written request.

10. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

These Trial Terms are governed by Danish law. Any disputes arising from or in connection with these Trial Terms shall first be attempted to be resolved by good-faith negotiation. If unresolved, disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Copenhagen, Denmark.

11. Record of Acceptance

This agreement is accepted electronically via the sign-up form on anubion.io. No physical signature is required. Upon acceptance, Anubion records the following for documentation purposes:

- Date and time of acceptance (UTC).
- Full name and email address of the submitting user.
- Customer legal entity name and registration number.
- Version of these Trial Terms accepted (as shown in the document footer).
- Version of the Data Processing Agreement accepted.
